Audit Program

The verification began with an opening meeting. The discussion covered the scope and purpose of the audit, the audit schedule and process, and the escort responsibilities. The ABS audit team gathered objective evidence of compliance through the observation of daily activities, interviews of crew members, and the sampling of pertinent records on board the ship. This information was compared to the existing policies and procedures of the company and the requirements of the ISPS Code Part A, and relevant sections of Part B (8.1-13.8), to determine the levels of compliance obtained. The Audit Plan depicts the departments audited and clauses against which they were assessed.

The verification ended with a closing meeting. The discussion included a review of the activities carried out, presentation of the deficiencies (if any), and review of the notable Observations made during the course of the audit.

Objective
